HPNC aims to support current efforts and take initiative in the following ways:

- Convene organizers and articulate current ecosystem
- Create central webpage/resource guide with links to volunteer opportunities
- Activate volunteer outreach and neighborhood network
- Invite our new neighbors into our current programs (Tot Lot, OST, Athletics)
- Develop specialized supports, including bi-lingual tutoring and ESL classes
- Open our building during quiet times and invite partners and volunteers to run key support activities
- Collaborate on other creative ideas
